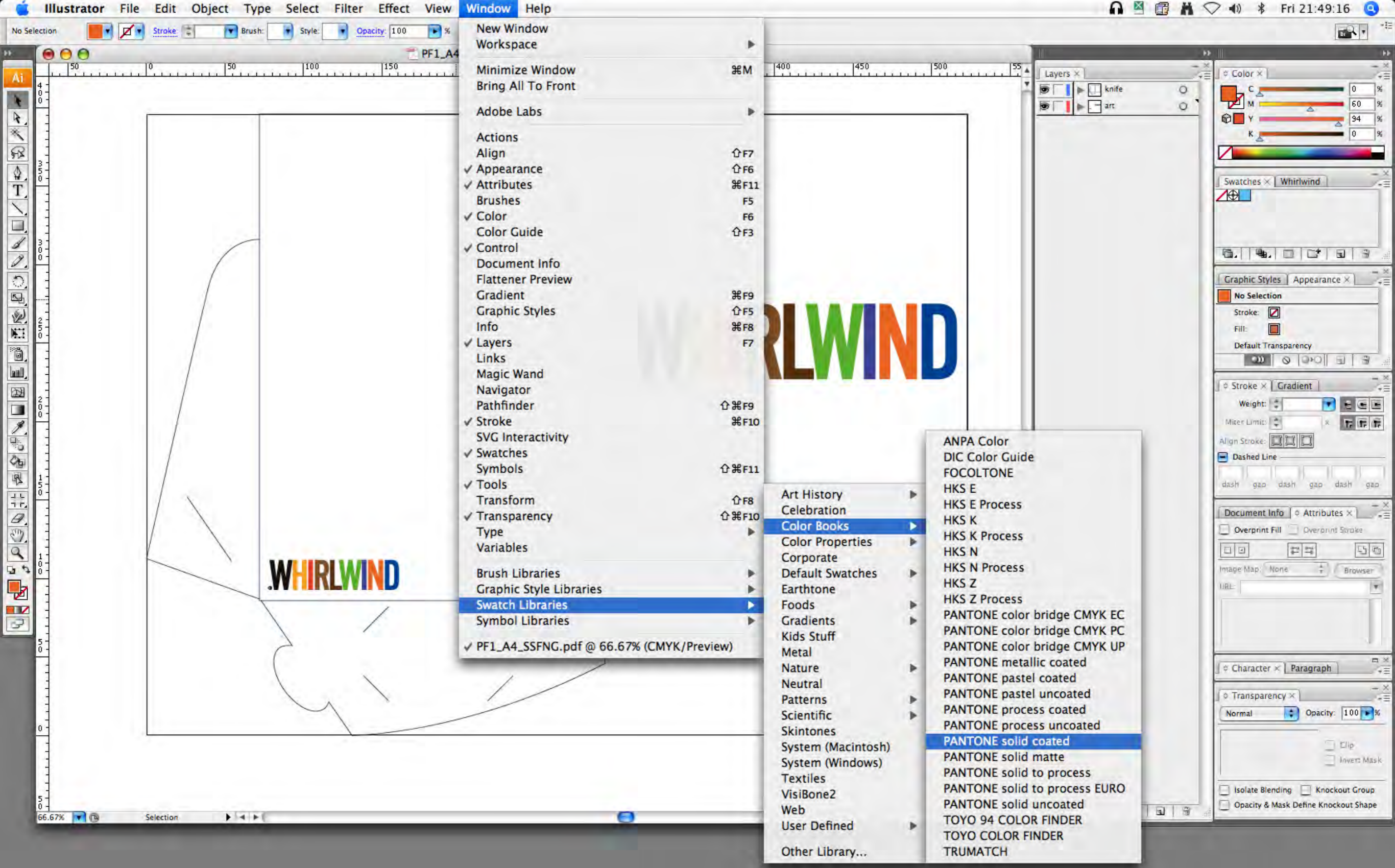


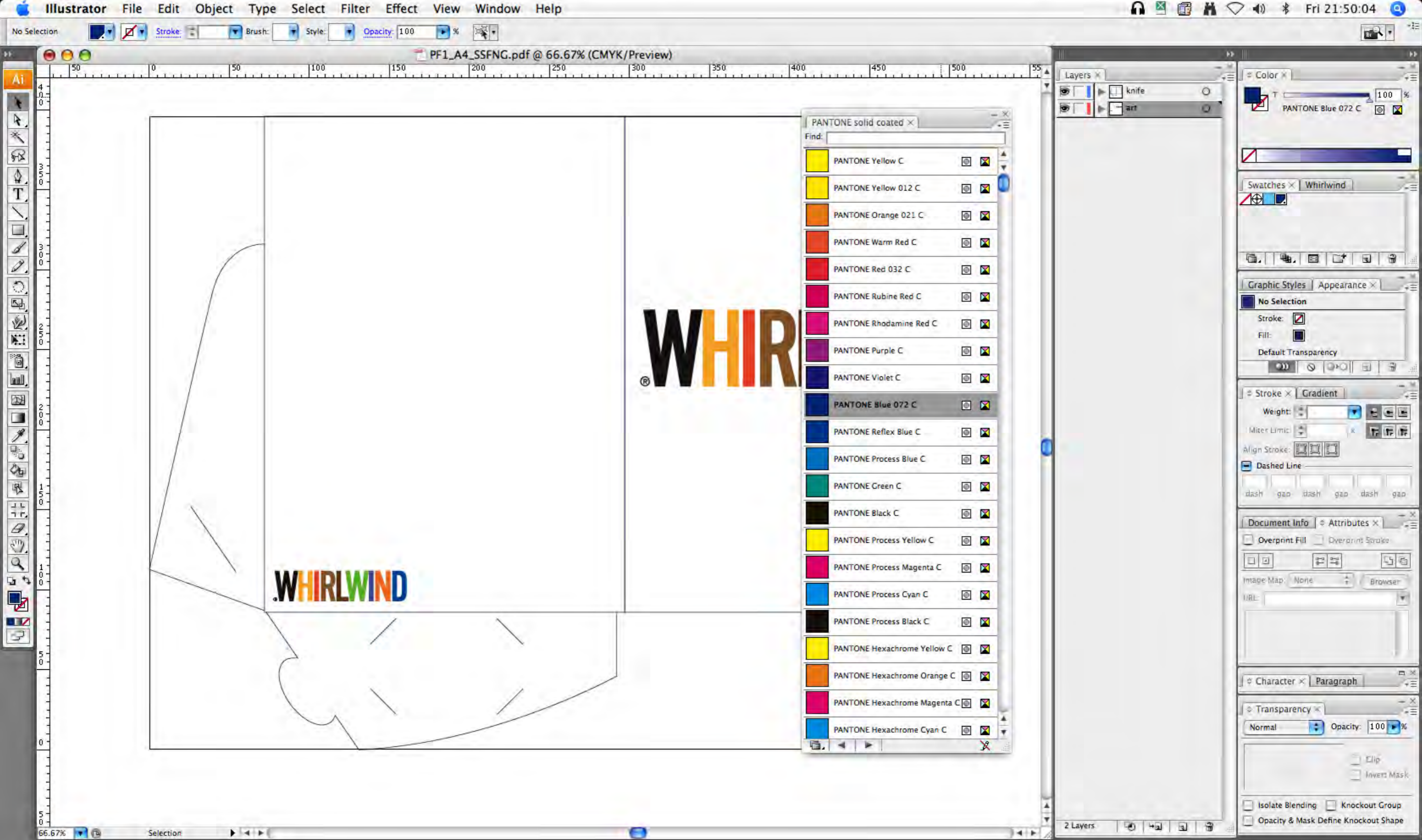
Setting up a knife line for die cutting

1. Choose the correct Pantone color

- Open the Pantone Solid Coated swatch book
- Select Pantone 072



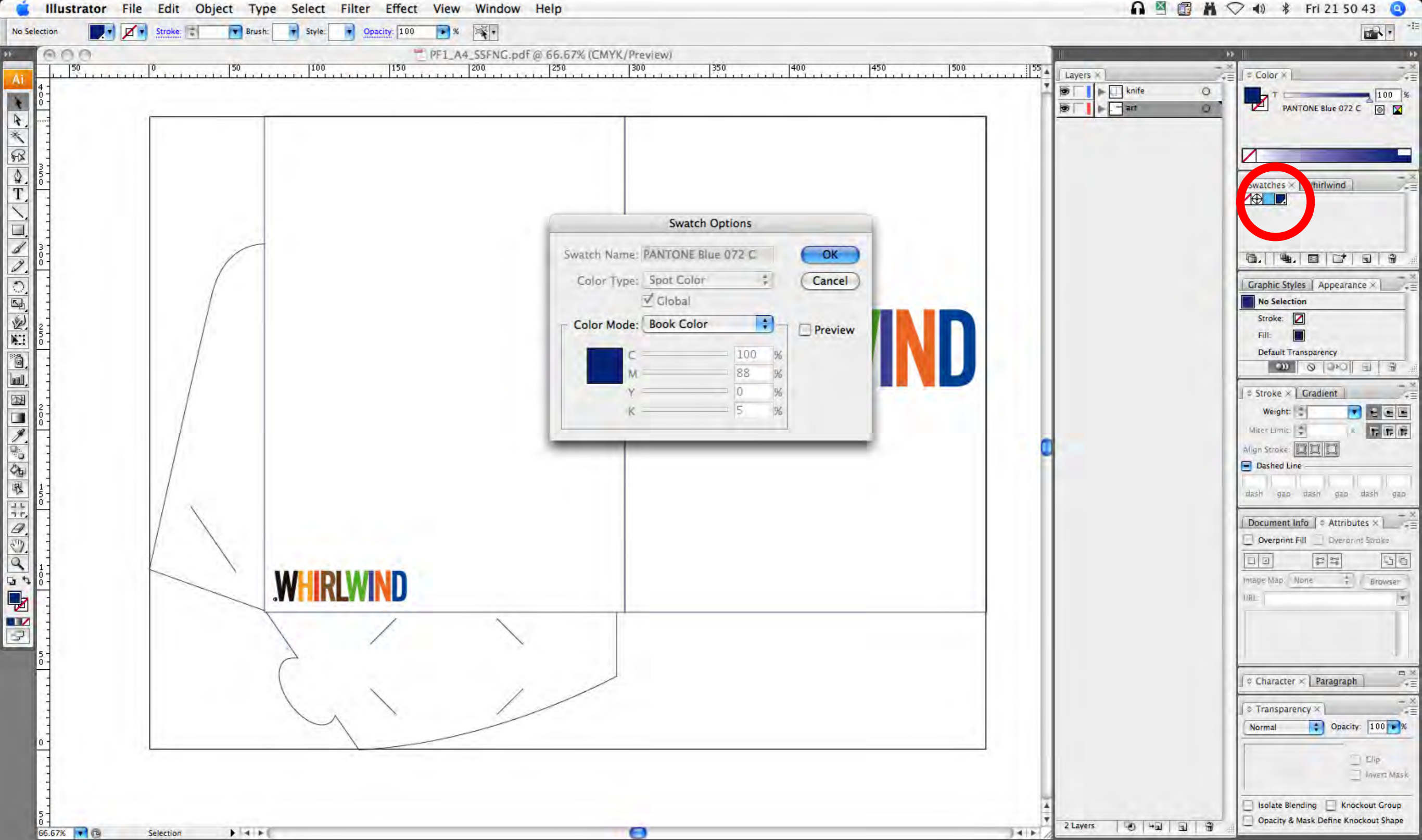

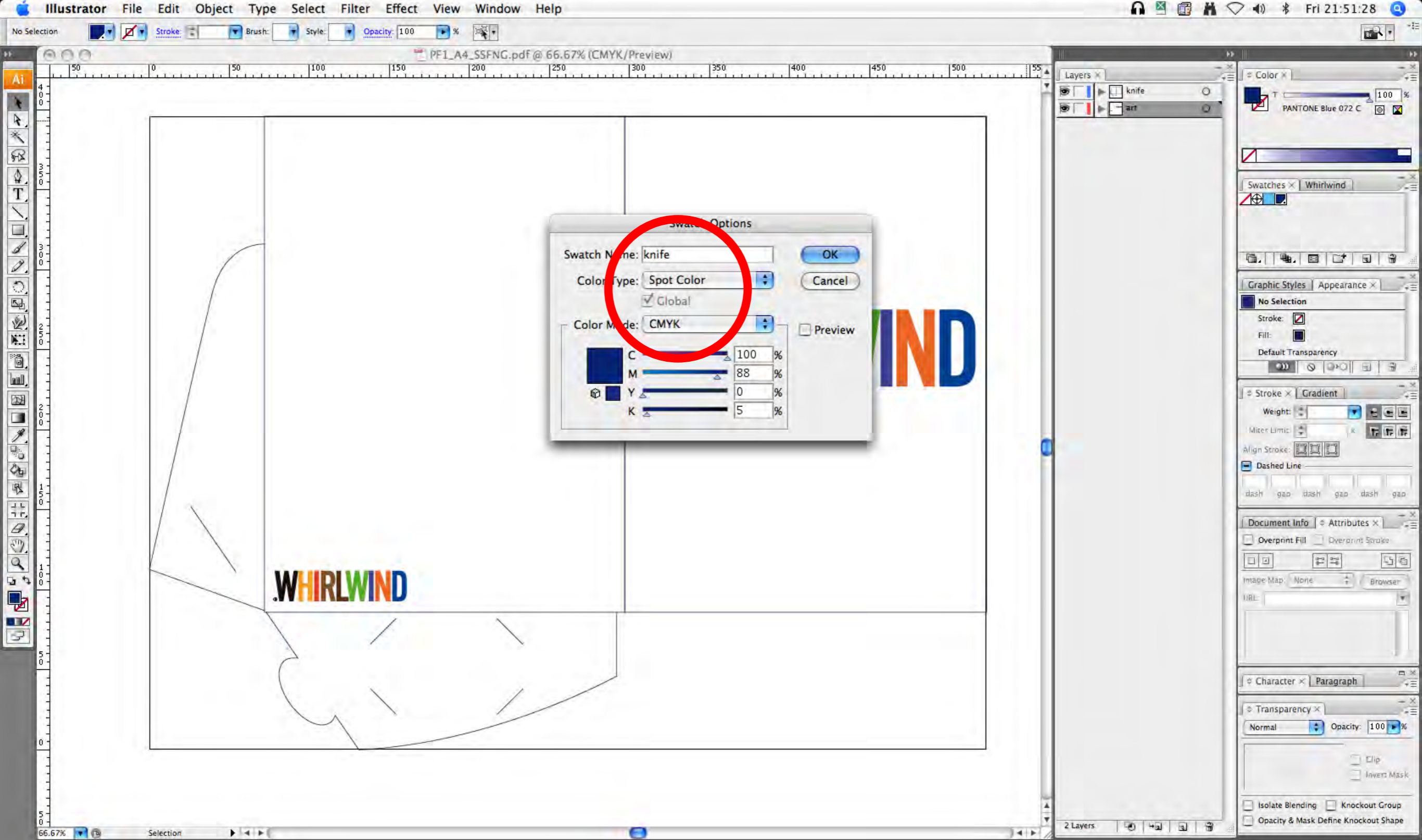

2. Rename the Pantone color

- From the swatches window, double click the new colour
- Change the Color Mode to CMYK
- Manually rename to knife (all lower case)



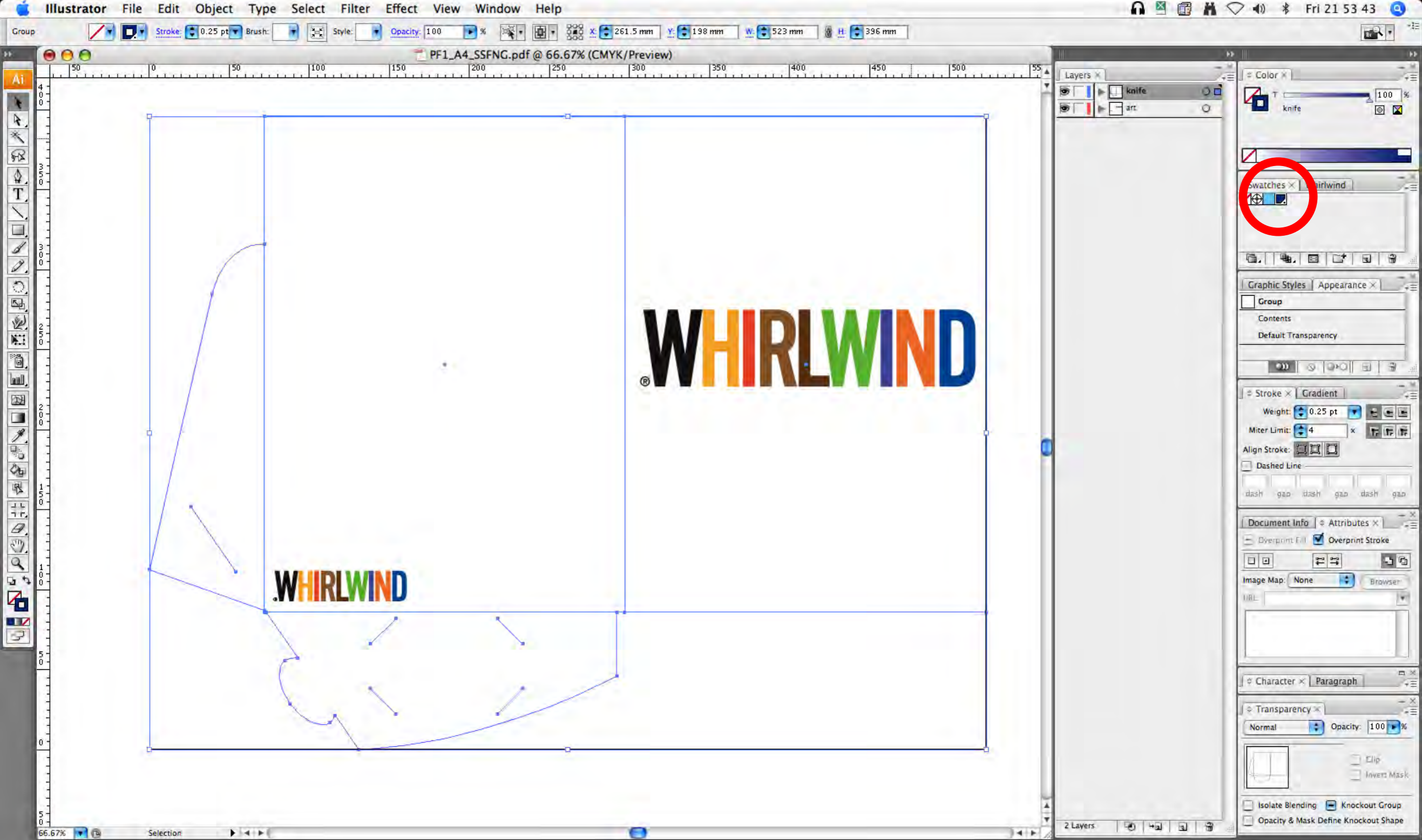

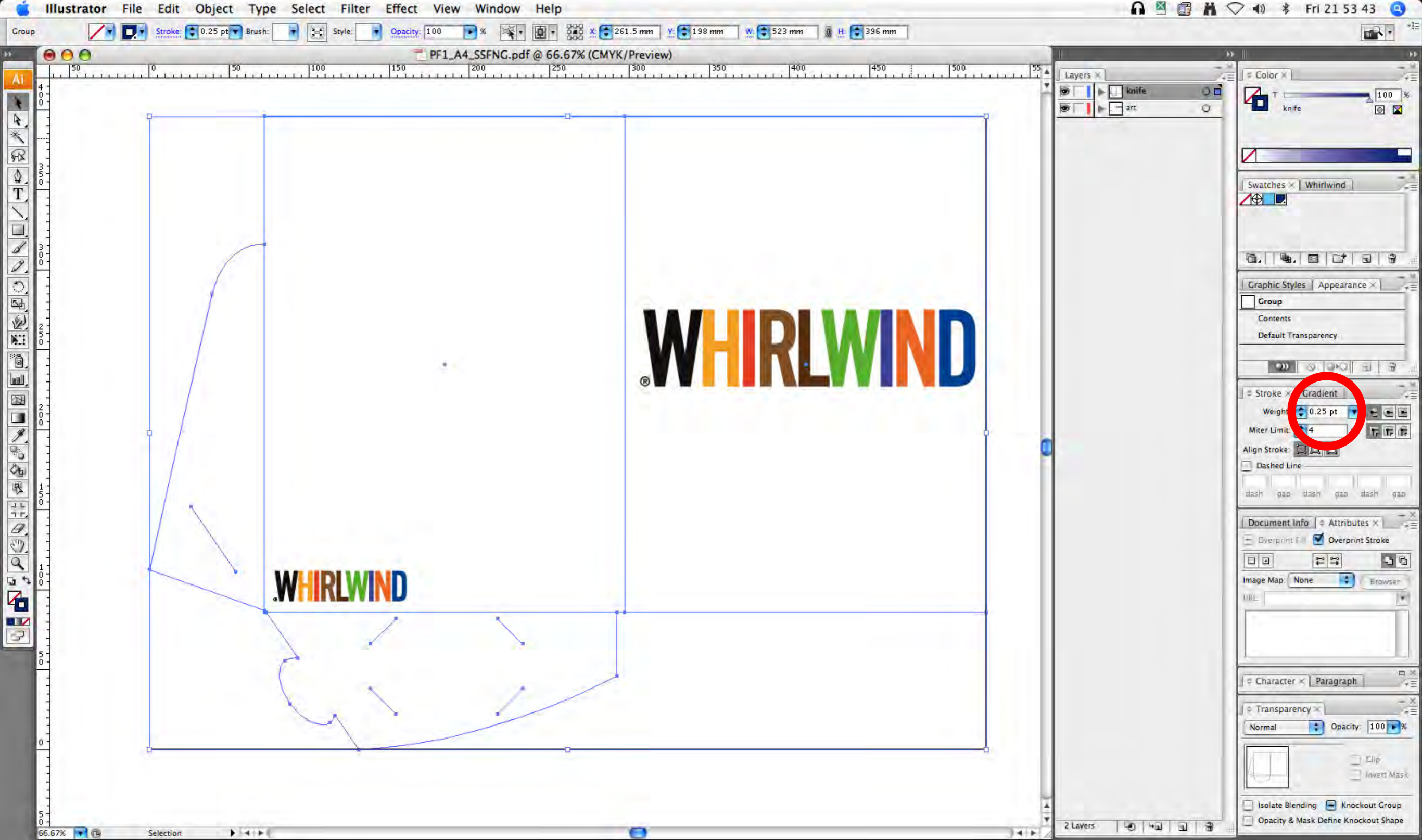

3. Create the knife line

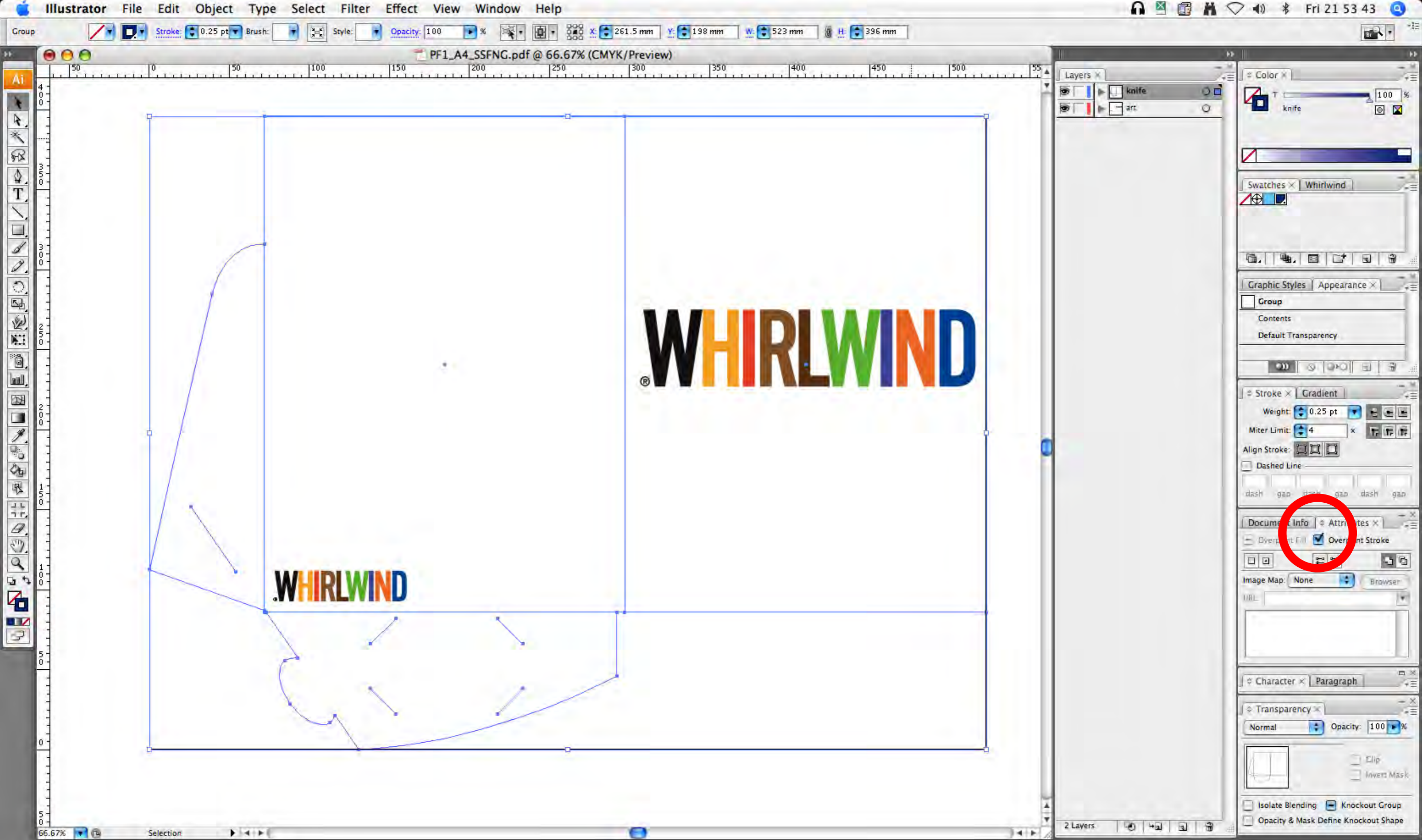
- Group the artwork to be formecut and select it
- From the Color window, click the Stroke option
- From the Swatches window, click the new knife color
- From the Stroke window, set the stroke weight to 0.25
- From the Attributes window, set the stroke to Overprint

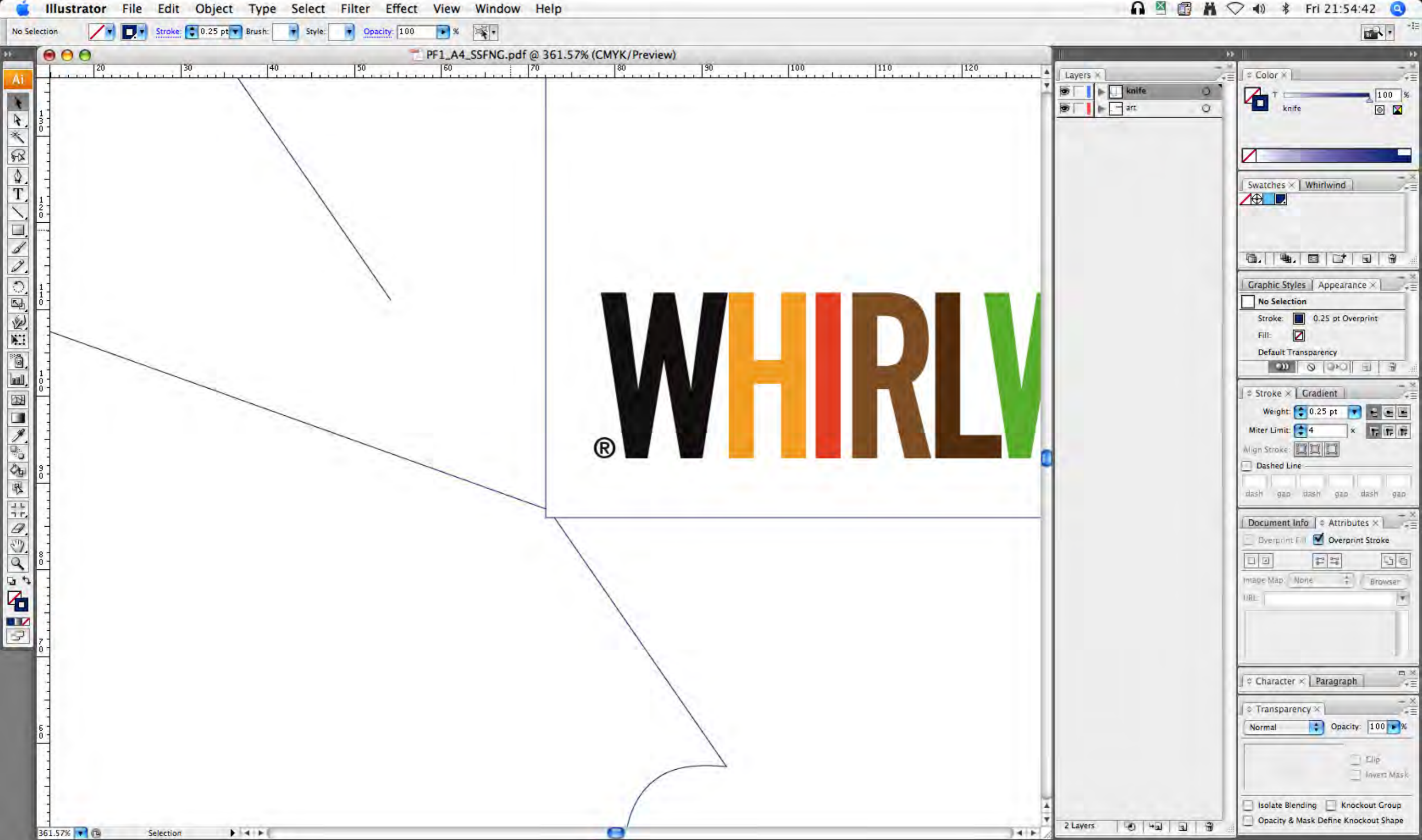
